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SCHOOL SYSTEM IN ROMANIA

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The levels of Romanian education:

- 1) Kindergarten (between age 3-7)
- 2) Primary school: classes 1st - 4th (between age 7-10)
- 3) Middle school: classes 5th - 8th (between age 10-14)
- 4) High school: classes 9th - 12th (between age 14-18)
- 5) University: 3-6 years

Kindergarten:

- Is available for children from three years old until they reach seven.
- All kindergartens provide at least one snack or meal for their students. Some kindergartens have their own kitchen with cooks preparing the meals.

A kindergarten:



Primary school:

- Elementary school or primary school is the first compulsory educational level in Romania.
- Most subjects for the first four years are taught by one main teacher. Primary subjects include Math, Romanian and Hungarian Language, History, Geography, English, Arts, Religion, Music, Physical Education and Civic Education.

Middle school:

- Upper level students (fifth grade onwards) have additional subjects like Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Latin and Technology. Some schools also optional subjects.
- At the end of the eight grade students have an exam, and depending on their grades they can choose high school.

High school:

There are more types of high schools:

1) Standard:

they usually offer both the *real* (math-informatics, natural sciences) and *uman* (languages, social studies) sections

2) Military:

are considered extremely strict and legally they have the same regime as army units

A military school:



3) Technologic:

they usually offer academic programmes in the field of technical or services education

4) Economic or Technical:

high schools with an academic programme based on services or technical education and good results.

A technologic school:



5) Arts:

these specific high schools offer education in visual arts for students, like painting, sculpture, and graphic design

Graduating high school requires to have the National Final Exam (Baccalaureate). This examination consists of oral and written exams.

University:

The admission in higher education requests a baccalaureate diploma and differs from one university to another.
